In order to fulfill the information obligation under Article 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (Journal of Laws EU L.2016.119.1, amended by Journal of Laws EU.L.2018.127.2), hereinafter referred to as GDPR - we inform that:

3. Your personal data will be processed in order to conclude and/or to ensure the proper implementation of the contract between the Data Controller and

(contractor's data) in connection with your representation and/or being a contact person in the implementation of this contract and in order to meet legal obligations incumbent upon the Data Controller and the possible need to defend or exercise civil law claims in relation to this contract.

4. The legal basis for processing of your personal data is the legitimate interest of the Data Controller referred to in Art. 6 section 1 letter f of GDPR, however, the conclusion and implementation of the above agreement, as well as the protection of the property and non-property rights of the Data Controller in connection with the possible need to defend



or exercise civil law claims, are indicated as a legitimate interest. In addition, the legal basis for the processing of your personal data is Art. 6 section 1 letter c of GDPR, due to the fact that the processing is necessary to fulfill the legal obligations incumbent upon the Data Controller, under applicable law in connection with the concluded contrach.

- 5. We process your personal data in the field of ordinary data: name, surname, e-mail address, telephone number, place of work, position, in addition, if attaching the power of attorney of the representative, data included in the power of attorney.
- 6. The data provided by you will not be disclosed to third parties. The recipients of the data may be only:
 - 1) Bodies and institutions authorized to obtain data on the basis of applicable law (e.g. Border Guard, Customs Office, Civil Aviation Office, and Tax Office).
 - 2) Providers of legal and consulting services (in particular law firms).
 - 3) Entities processing data on our behalf under the data processing entrustment agreement.
- 7. In addition, your personal data will be disclosed to authorized persons employed by the Data Controller on the basis of employment contracts or civil-law contracts.
- 8. The Data Controller does not intend to transfer personal data to a third country or international organization.
- 9. Your personal data will be kept for the period of implementation of the contract with the above-mentioned contractor whom you represent and/or who appointed you to contact us, and for the period required by law, however not less than the limitation period for possible claims relating to the conclusion and implementation of the contract.

You have the right to request access to your personal data, its rectification, deletion, or restriction of the processing, as well as the right to submit an objection against the processing and the right to oppose any further processing and the right to transfer the data. If the processing of personal data is conducted on the basis of Art. 6 section 1 letter a of GDPR, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time with no impact on the lawfulness of the processing conducted on the basis of consent given prior to its withdrawal.
- 13. You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, i.e. President of the Office for Personal Data Protection).
